WHY TRYING TO PLEASE EVERYONE IS A TRAP

1. IT CAUSES ME TO MISS GOD'S PURPOSE FOR ME

"<u>Our purpose</u> is to please God, not people. He is the one who examines the motives of our hearts."

1 Thessalonians 2:4b (NLT)

2. IT KEEPS MY FAITH FROM GROWING

"You try to get <u>praise from each other</u>, but <u>you do not try</u> to get the praise that comes from the only God. So <u>how can you</u> <u>believe</u>?" John 5:44 (NCV)

3. IT LEADS TO SIN

"Do not follow the crowd in doing wrong!" Exodus 23:2a (NIV)

"Then Saul said to Samuel, "<u>I have sinned</u>; I have indeed transgressed the command of the Lord and your words, because <u>I feared the people</u> and listened to their voice." 1 Samuel 15:24 (NAS)

4. IT CAUSES HYPOCRISY

"He said to them, "You are the ones who justify yourselves in the eyes of men, but God knows your hearts" Luke 16:15 (NIV)

"You may brag about yourself, but <u>the only approval that counts</u> is the Lord's approval." 2 Corinthians 10:18 (CEV)

5. IT SILENCES MY WITNESS

"<u>No one had the courage to speak favorably</u> about Jesus in public, for they were <u>afraid of getting in trouble</u> with the leaders." John 7:13 (NLT) "Many people, including leaders, believed in Jesus. But they wouldn't talk about it publicly <u>out of their fear</u> that the Pharisees <u>would expel them</u> from the synagogue. They <u>loved human approval</u> <u>more than they loved the approval of God</u>." John 12:42-43

SIX FACTS TO REMEMBER

1. EVEN GOD CAN'T PLEASE EVERYONE!

Example: If two people pray about the rain – 1 prays for rain and 1 for no rain, one of them will not be pleased by God sending rain. Likewise, if two people on opposing teams pray to win a sports event, one of them will be disappointed!

2. I DON'T NEED ANYONE'S APPROVAL TO BE HAPPY!

Jesus: "Your approval or disapproval means nothing to me." John 5:41 (NLT)

"I am the One who comforts you! So why are you afraid of mere humans, who wither like the grass and disappear?" Isaiah 51:12 (NLT)

"Even if my father and mother abandon me, the Lord will hold me close." Psalm 27:10 (NLT)

3. WHAT SEEMS SO IMPORTANT IS ONLY TEMPORARY

"The world and <u>everything in it that people desire</u> is passing away; but those who do the will of God will live forever." 1 John 2:17 (TEV)

Jesus: "<u>The things that are highly valued by people are worth</u> <u>nothing in God's sight</u>." Luke 16:15b (TEV)

4. I ONLY HAVE TO PLEASE ONE PERSON!

Jesus: "I don't try to please myself, but I only please the One who sent me." John 5:30 (NCV)

Paul: "I'm not trying to be a people pleaser! No, I am trying to please God. If I were still trying to please people, I would not be Christ's servant." Galatians 1:10 (NLT)

5. ONE DAY I WILL GIVE AN ACCOUNT OF MY LIFE
