WHEN SHOULD I MOVE FAST?

1. WHEN GOD TELLS ME TO DO SOMETHING

“Jesus said to them, ‘Come follow me...’ So, Simon and Andrew immediately left their nets and followed him.” Mark 1:17-18 (NCV)

“Without delay, I hurry to obey your command.” Psalm 119:60 (TEV)

2. WHEN I NEED TO ASK OR OFFER FORGIVENESS

“If you are giving an offering at worship and you suddenly remember that someone has something against you, leave your offering and go immediately to that person and be reconciled. Then you can come back to worship and offer your gift.”

Matthew 5:23-24

3. WHEN I FEEL TEMPTED

“RUN away from all evil things...” 1 Timothy 6:11 (NLT)

“RUN away from the worship of idols...” 1 Corinthians 10:14 (NCV)

“RUN away from sexual sin...” 1 Corinthians 6:18 (NLT)

4. WHEN I’VE MADE A PROMISE TO GOD

“When you make a promise to God, keep it as quickly as possible. He isn’t happy with foolish people. Do what you promised to do!”

Ecclesiastes 5:4 (TEV)

5. WHEN I HAVE AN OPPORTUNITY TO DO GOOD

“Do not withhold good from those who deserve it, while it is in your power to act!” Proverbs 3:27 (NIV)

6. WHEN GOD OFFERS ME SALVATION

3. WHEN MAKING A MAJOR DECISION
